As we start a new Religious Education year there will be some slight changes in our program.

During the summer an email was sent to all who were registered in the program last year asking for input regarding the times our classes were held. Several options were suggested. The response that recorded the most favorable return was to begin class **at 6:30 PM and conclude at 7:30 PM**. This option was favored by younger families so they could have the children home a bit earlier in preparation for bed.

In addition, this year we have adopted a new curriculum with many very distinct advantages. With each textbook there comes a e-version that can be accessed by the child and parents at home. So, questions that may come up in the classroom may be researched further on-line at home. We are excited about this because the parents can see exactly what the students are doing in the classroom. In addition, there are activities and games the family can participate in at home. As a result, we will have to increase our fees: **\$75.00 for the first child and \$140.00 maximum for the family**.
