Parents do have the right to refuse your child's to participation in this program, but parents must sign a waiver form located in the Religious Ed. Office.

Inclement Weather

There are times during the year when it becomes necessary to cancel classes because of the weather. Check the latest cancellations on all local TV stations and their websites. **If school is canceled because of weather, Religious Education classes are automatically canceled.** Emergency message regarding Religious Education will be disseminated over the parish "One Call" system or you may call the office at 402-468-5659.

Please keep the parking lot safe by entering the parking lot at the N. 13th Street entrance and exiting at the Clay street exit. Parents of children in grades K-6th grade will need to go to the classroom to pick up their child. (*A child will only be released to parents or siblings 7th grade and older.*) This new requirement has made the hall and the parking a lot safer with less children running around trying to find their transportation. Also, for the safety of your children, please make sure they are walking home with a parent or older siblings.
